2008 Senior's Rules

1. The rules of this tournament as stated below will remain unchanged. Any questions will be left to the tournament director for final decision.

2. **GENERAL:** Team members must fish from the same boat and must stay together and within sight of each other during all fishing hours. The contestants must leave the starting area and return to it by boat. All boats must stay in the water during fishing hours.

3. **TACKLE:** Casting, spinning and flipping tackle may be used. However no more than one-rod or fishing line may be in use at any one time by each contestant. Only artificial lures may be used. No live or prepared bait will be allowed with the exception of pork rinds, chunks, and strips.

4. **BOATS/MOTORS:** It is the responsibility of each team to provide for their own use a boat meeting the following requirements: Boats must be a minimum of 14 feet in length. Each boat must have an operating live well capable of aerating or circulating a limit of **(5) FIVE FISH.** Each boat must have a functional kill switch. The tournament director reserves the right to disqualify any team, which is operating an extremely overpowered boat. All boats and motors must meet state requirements for safety standards.

5. **BOAT OPERATION:** Sportsmanship and safe boating are paramount at all times. Each contestant must wear a U.S. Coast Guard approved life preserver any time the main engine is in use.

6. **FISHING:** Fishing is permitted anywhere on the lake except, within 50 yards of a marina gas pump or another contestants anchored boat with the trolling motor out of the water. All fishing must be done from the contestants boat and all fish must be landed from within the contestants boat. All state fishing rules and regulations will apply. Tournament daily possession will be **(5) FIVE fish per team.** No culling of fish at the weigh-in site will be permitted. A courtesy bump board will be provided at each event. **You may have 2 substitutes during the regular season, there will no substitutes for the classic!**

7. **SCORING:** Only largemouth, smallmouth, or spotted bass will be weighed for score. Scoring will be by a decimal weight. Bass, which are less than the lake or river legal length will be disqualified and a 1.0-pound penalty will be imposed for each fish, found to be too short, from the team's total weight. There will also be a 1.0-pound penalty for each dead fish that is brought to the scales. The tournament director will determine a dead fish. Any team/contestant, which brings in more than the tournament limit will be disqualified for that day. All fish will be returned to tournament water. **No Exceptions!**

8. **Contestants:** Male or Female may fish Got 2 Love It Seniors events **as long as they turn 50 in the year of the events. This means if you will turn 50 by 12/31/08.**

9. **OFF LIMITS:** Off limits is sunset the day before each event.

10. **LATE PENALTY:** Contestants who fail to check in at the official check-in boat at the appointed time will be penalized at the rate of **1.0 pound per minute** deducted from the total weight of their catch for that day, including any weight to be counted toward a big bass. Any competitor more than fifteen minutes late will lose all credit for that days catch. There shall be no excuses for tardiness.

11. **WEATHER:** The start and finish times for the tournament may be adjusted if the tournament director determines that the weather conditions prohibit safe operation. The total fishing time allotted for each team will remain equal for all teams.

12. **PROTESTS:** All valid protests will be heard and considered by the tournament director. Any contestant wishing to lodge a protest against another contestant must do so in writing and signed by the protester with-in 15 minutes from the conclusion of the weigh-in.. The tournament director will make the final decision.

13. **TIES:** All ties will be determined by the number of fish in the creel. A tie for big bass will also be determined by the same way. A flip of a coin will determine a tie after that, along with who receives awards.

14. **ALCOHOL:** No alcoholic beverages or drugs are permitted in any boat during tournament hours.

15. **STATE LAWS:** Any cited, major infraction of state boating laws that are reported to Tournament Director by the D.N.R. may result in disqualification. Also any unsafe boating operation that is brought to the attention of the tournament director.

16. **CHEATING:** A stress test may be given to the 1st place team and (3) other teams to be determined by The tournament director. Anyone that is caught cheating will be disqualified from these events and will be ineligible from future Got 2 Love It events!

17. **ENTRY DEADLINE:** The first 175 boats or the Lake or River limit. A confirmation card will be mailed to each team captain when received. There will be a **\$25.00** late fee for entries received after the midnight Friday before the tournament deadline.

18. **INSURANCE:** All boats in GOT 2 LOVE IT events must have a minimum of \$100,000.00 liability insurance, and must have upon request, a certificate of proof of insurance in stated amount.

19. **POINT SYSTEM & CLASSIC:** We will use a point system in all events; 1st. place will receive 150 pts. 2nd. Place will receive 149 pts. until there no points or positions remaining among the anglers that have caught fish. All ties will receive the same amount of points! The **Top 50%** in the point standings that have **fished 5 of the 6 events** will fish a 2-day classic at the end of the season along with the **six** other lucky teams that are drawn at the six events in division. You must be present at these events to win one of these free entries. these 6 lucky teams must have fished all 6 events to go to the classic. **New in 2008> 10%** of all entries received in the qualifying events will go into the classic fund! The remaining 5% will go into the ramp payback. Please go to the payout page at got2loveit.com for further details. The entry fee for the Seniors Classic will be \$100.00. The Top 5 Teams & the 2008 Points Champions will pay no entry fee to fish the classic.
